How does it work?

Attendees will be asked to self-certify using Eventcombo's specially designed Vaccine Checker during the event registration, before simply showing their Vaccine Pass at the door before entry.

Checking will be done via the app and will sync with a real time dashboard to ensure organizers are aware of the vaccine status of their audience.

Despite every city, region or country having their own mandate and authority, the app allows each organizer to be able to validate their audience's vaccine status based on their local jurisdiction and requirements.
